The NSSN is undergoing a re-design as part of the launch of ANSI's new web platform slated for release in Q4 2012. The enhanced NSSN is designed to better assist users by providing a mechanism through which they can identify potentially conflicting and duplicative standards projects in the early stages of development. Outreach to ANSI membership and non-members for data  Since ANSI will also include non-ANS development data in the NSSN, this will require the participation and cooperation of a broader set of developing organizations. ANSI is requesting its constituency to assist in identifying the contacts within their organizations to obtain the data feeds necessary to populate NSSN with their development data. Additionally, ANSI is seeking assistance in identifying other organizations (non-ANS developers, consortia, etc.) so that their development data can be integrated.
