



**ANSI Standards Developer Audit:  
Required Documentation for Technical Reports (TR) Registered with ANSI**

In connection with an ANSI Audit, ANSI-Accredited Standards Developers (ASD) are required to make available the documentation listed below for selected TRs that are registered with ANSI. The procedures that govern the registration process are the *ANSI Procedures for Registration of Technical Reports*.

ANSI's oversight and audit apply only to TRs registered with ANSI and not to any other TRs.

**1. Criteria for a Technical Report Registered with ANSI**

- a. A Technical Report registered with ANSI shall be entirely informative in nature and shall not contain information implying that it is a standard.
- b. The American National Standards (ANS) designation or mark shall not be used on a TR that is registered with ANSI.
- c. The TR shall clearly explain its relationship to aspects of the subject which are, or will be, dealt with in related American National Standards.

**2. The Audit will review evidence of compliance with the following:**

- a. The ANSI Patent Policy, if applicable
- b. The *ANSI Policy Regarding Rights to Nationally Adopt IEC and ISO Standards or Otherwise Use IEC and ISO Material*, if applicable
- c. Inclusion in the Foreword of the following text (or equivalent):

"Publication of this Technical Report has been approved by the Accredited Standards Developer (include name here). This document is registered as a Technical Report series of publications according to the *Procedures for the Registration of Technical Reports with ANSI*. This document is not an American National Standard and the material contained herein is not normative in nature. Comments on the content of this document should be sent to \_\_\_\_ (Accredited Standards Developer name and address)."

- d. Inclusion in the Foreword of a rationale for the publication of the TR
- e. Technical Report procedures are documented

- I. Procedures include an appeals process
  - II. Technical Report procedures are on file with ANSI
- f. A TR Registration Form (PSA-01) was submitted to ANSI prior to any reference to the TR's status as a TR Registered with ANSI
- g. The TR is maintained in accordance with associated procedures and the TR has not passed its tenth anniversary of registration without a maintenance action
- h. Designation and publication requirements:
- I. A TR that is registered with ANSI shall have its cover or title page marked with the words " "a Technical Report prepared by (name of accredited standards developer) and registered with ANSI". The date of registration shall be included in the published TR, preferably on the cover.
  - II. The TR is identified by a unique alphanumeric designation in accordance with *Procedures for Registration of Technical Reports with ANSI*.
  - III. The TR was published and made available within 3 months of registration, if possible, but no longer than 6 months.
