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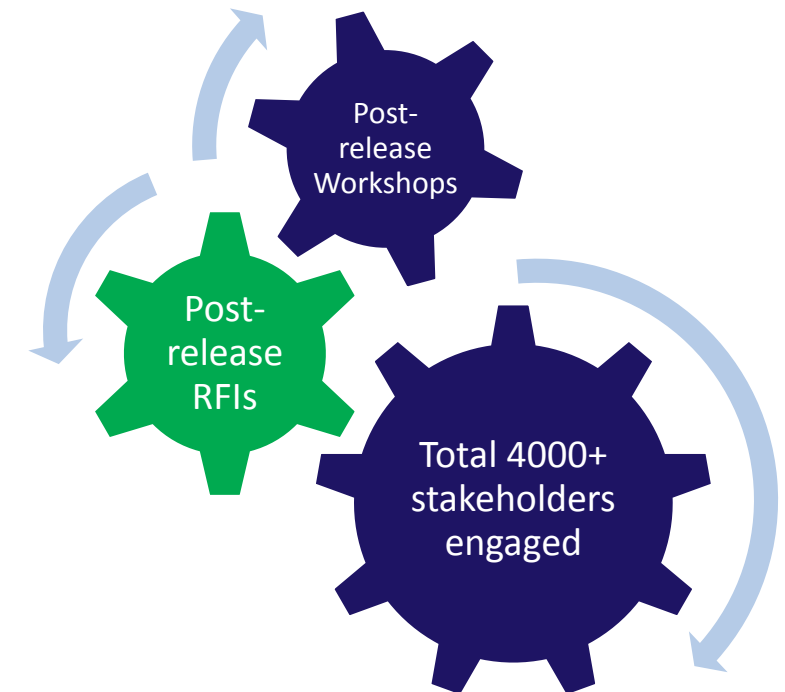
Opportunities for Collaboration and Engagement

- The ICT industry is supportive of China's standardization reform agenda and appreciates the opportunity for active collaboration with SAC throughout the process.
- The ICT industry appreciates opportunities to engage directly with SAC and China standards setting organizations such as TC 260.
- There are many avenues for the U.S. and China to collaborate, such as on foundational standards in areas implicating significant ICT trends and emerging technologies such as Internet of Things (IoT) and cybersecurity.
- The most productive path for all stakeholders is if such foundational standards are developed through a process that includes industry as a full participant.
 - The process for creating the Cybersecurity Framework provides a great example of an industry-driven, public-private collaboration that leverages international standards and best practices.
