Things We All Know About SDOs

- ANSI accredited SDOs are national in scope

- Examples:
 - ASTM International
 - IEEE

Things We All Know About SDOs

- SDOs Serve a Single Industry

- Examples:

 - ASTM

 - IEEE

Things We All Know About Consortia

- Consortia have a Narrow Focus
 - Most only set and maintain one or two standards
 - They're here and then they're gone
- Examples:
 - W3C
 - OASIS
 - OMG
 - The Open Group

Things We All Know About Consortia

- Consortia Only Represent Vendors

- Examples:
 - ACORD
 - Open Geospatial Consortium

Things We All Know About Consortia

- ❑ Consortium Standards Aren't "Real" Standards

- ❑ Only SDO standards have global recognition

- ❑ Examples of consortia that just don't cut it:
 - OASIS
 - W3C
 - OGC

Things We All Know About SSOs

- ANSI Organizational Members Are All Accredited
 - Example: ACORD

- SSOs Run All of Their Standards Under a Single Process
 - Example: ASTM

- SDOs Keep to SDOs and Consortia Keep to Consortia
 - Example: Liaison Relationships

Things We All Know About Members

- Government is Only Interested in SDOs Because of their Process
 - Example: NIST

- Companies Only Participate in One Type of Organization or the Other
 - IBM
 - Microsoft
 - Intel
