Overview

Interoperability is the ability of two or more networks, systems, devices, applications or components to exchange information between them and use the information so exchanged.

A two-day conference jointly-sponsored by the three European Standards Organizations (CEN, CENELEC and ETSI) and the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) will provide a forum for a global discussion of how standards and compliance systems can be used as tools to facilitate the interoperability of information and communication technologies that underpin the development of mass markets for a broad range of industry sectors.

The event will tackle issues such as home and building electronic systems (HBES), eBusiness interoperability, radio frequency identification devices (RFID), entertainment (multimedia, digital TV), eHealth, eLearning, eSkills and eGovernment, and more. Discussions will include technical interoperability demonstration and testing, as well as the quality of standards.

Attendees

The event is open to all stakeholders, including consumers and consumer representatives, government legislative and regulatory bodies, industry, standards developing organizations, certification organizations, and other interested parties.

Nearly 200 attendees are expected, including representatives of industry, officials of the European Commission, representatives of the Polish and American governments, representatives of the standardization and conformity assessment community.

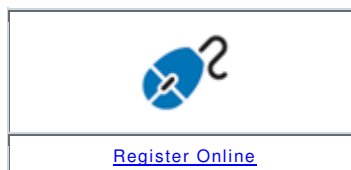
