Developing Countries Key Discussion/Consensus Points

- We support the five key objectives:
 - raising awareness;
 - building capacity;
 - encouraging bilateral and regional cooperation;
 - providing assistance on IT tools necessary to work in ISO and access its products and services; and
 - enhancing the participation of developing countries in ISO's governance and technical work.
- ISO should consider focused training for National Standards Bodies in developing countries on developing national consensus positions that involve all relevant stakeholders.



Developing Countries Key Discussion/Consensus Points

- Greater encouragement of bi-directional activities (e.g. twinning)
 - Develop key performance indicators on effectiveness and value of DEVCO programs
 - Promote how ISO engagement is relevant to and impacts developing countries
- ISO should determine the extent to which PASC, COPANT, and other regional standards groups can and might serve as a channel for identifying to ISO leadership developing country standardization priorities.
