Background

- 9/11
 - Reason to co-ordinate homeland security efforts in Europe (EU Commission, CEN, Industry)
- ☐ CEN/BT/WG 161 "Protection and security of the citizen"
 - First meeting in 2004 (3/11, same day as Madrid bombing)
 - Assessment of gaps and needs
- ☐ CEN/TC 391 "Societal and citizen security" (2009)









About CEN/TC 391 and CBRN activities

- ☐ CEN/TC 391
 - Close cooperation with ISO/TC 223 'Societal and citizen security'
 - Stakeholders see need for CBRN related standards
- ☐ CBRN in CEN/TC 391
 - EU CBRN Action Plan
 - 1st CBRN work item
 - New proposals
 - CBRN meeting, 24 October 2011, Vienna









Existing standards

- ☐ Few to no European standards on CBRN
 - Mostly technical solutions
 - Some that measure chemical substances
 - No overall CBRN solutions in Europe
- Need for CBRN standardization
 - First initiative to develop TS in 'CBRN Risk assessment, risk awareness and risk management'









CBRN RAAM – Why?

- Weak transnational coordination in emergency preparedness
- Lack of knowledge of CBRN risks among emergency responders
- No common vision on the application of equipment (detection, decontamination, PPE)
- Need for a common reference document









CBRN RAAM – What?

- Need for a reference document, supported by stakeholders
- Process description, methodology
- Scenario based, measurable actions
- Quality management aspects









CBRN RAAM – How?

- Start with awareness (no awareness, no support, no communication)
- Continue with assessment (quantify risks)
- ☐ Followed by management (measures, equipment, training, monitoring etc)
- Sustained by auditing (requirements laid down after assessment and management)
- Concluded by verification (adjusting the process parameters where needed)









CBRN RAAM – Who and when?

- Who
 - Experts appointed by CEN members
 - Experts appointed by liaisons
- When
 - Oct 2011: Kick-off
 - June 2012: Draft for comment
 - Nov 2012: Incorporating the comments, enhancing public support
 - Jan 2013: Published document
