The sixth in a series of ANSI-sponsored annual events focused on bringing together leaders of both accredited and non-accredited standards developers, the 2012 Open Forum was held in Washington, DC on October 9, 2012, as part of the [World Standards Week](#) series of events.

Open Forum 2012: *Building Bridges across the Standards Ecosystem* began with a networking lunch followed by a comprehensive program including a keynote address offering perspectives on global trade and market access for standards developers and consortia, an examination of a case study that effectively built standards development infrastructures, and two interactive panels and corresponding discussions covering standards for the global market, and building visibility and credibility throughout the standards ecosystem.

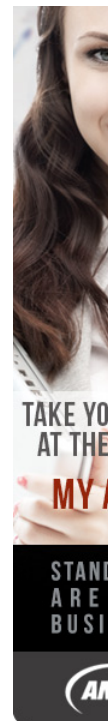
