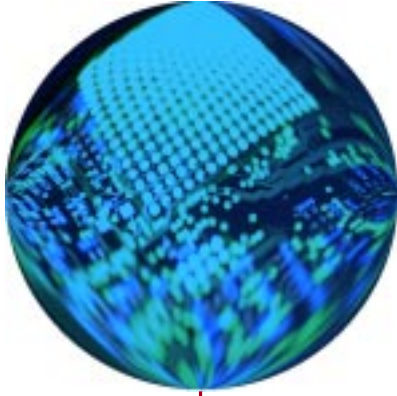

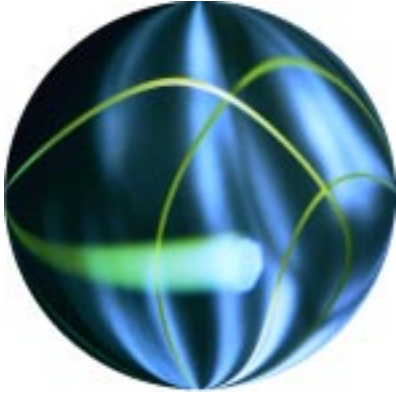

SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS:

• *Customer-Managed Access*

The Customer-Managed Access option allows you to host and manage licensed document collections within your domain. Standards and updates are provided quarterly. Employees access documents via your own internal document management system.

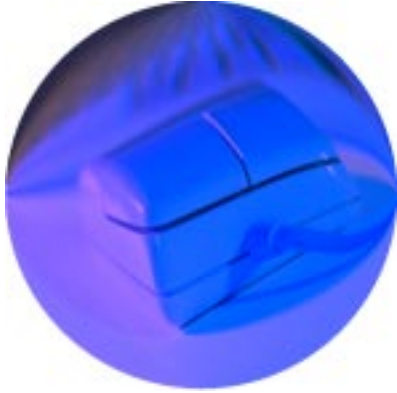
• *NSSN-Managed Access Service*

In addition to the ability to license documents, our NSSN-Managed Access Service includes an enterprise-wide license to one of the world's most comprehensive data networks for standards and technical information, the *NSSN: A National Resource for Global Standards* (www.nssn.org) and its Standards Tracking and Automated Reporting (STAR) Service.

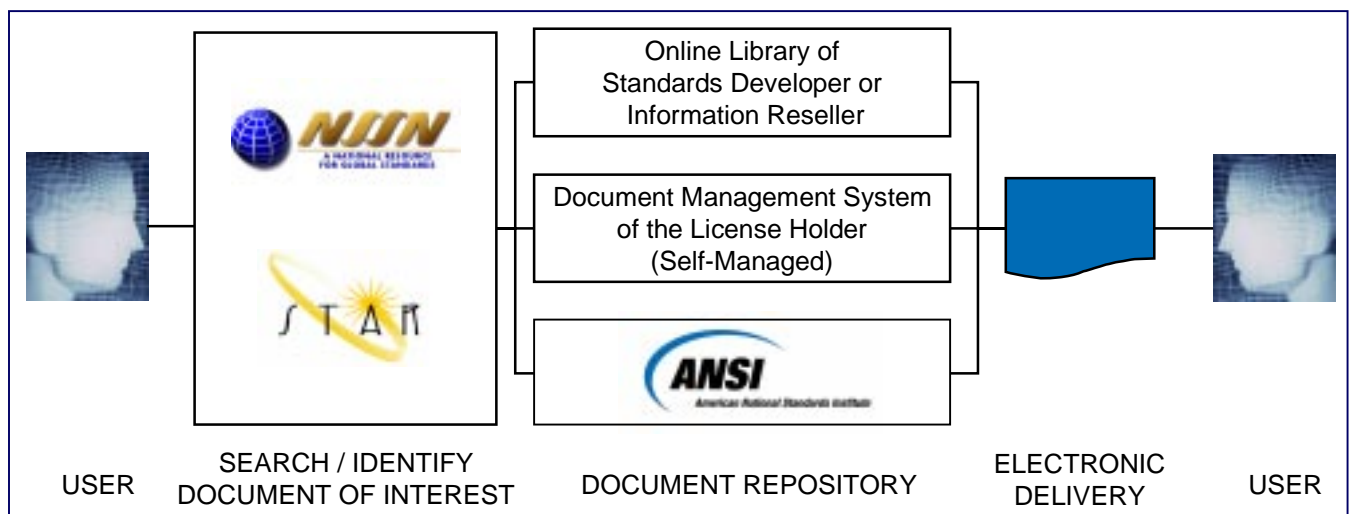
● *NSSN-Managed Access Service (continued)*

Document collections reside at ANSI or the electronic document warehouse of a standards developer or designated information reseller. Employees of your enterprise use the NSSN's *STAR* Service to identify and link to licensed documents.

Plus, you'll be able to fully utilize the unique, automated features of the *STAR* Service to identify new project proposals and changes in status of development projects or standards under maintenance.

No user ids or passwords are required.

SUMMARY OF OPTIONS:

- Licensed document(s) can reside at your own site; the standards developer's site or the site of a designated information reseller; or at the American National Standards Institute (ANSI).
- Manage the documents yourself; or let the NSSN do it for you.
- If you choose, ANSI will assist you in negotiations with third-party suppliers of electronic documents.

- ANSI is focused on your cost/value relationship. Our goal is to save you money and, at the same time, improve your performance by providing immediate access to the standards collections you need.

Annual license fees may be set to allow unlimited access for all employees enterprise-wide. License fees may be reduced if access is restricted to a limited number of employee users.

Standards or standards collections licensed through ANSI will be subject to an agreement considering usage (unlimited versus limited and domestic versus global access), volume (number of standards licensed), location (ANSI hosted, third-party hosted, or customer hosted), copyright, and text exploitation rights.

FEE STRUCTURE:

Single- and multi-year subscriptions are available, which include periodic updates.

• **Customer-Managed Access:**

Document collections are priced individually.

• **NSSN-Managed Access Service**

The enterprise-wide license to the NSSN and its STAR Service is \$7,500 (ANSI-members) or \$9,500 (non-members). Document collections are priced individually.



NSSN & STAR



• The NSSN is a comprehensive source of standards and technical information available on the World Wide Web (www.nssn.org).

Enterprise-wide customers receive access to searchable, bibliographic data on more than 270,000 approved and development projects, including national, foreign, regional and international standards from over 600 voluntary, corporate and government standards developers. At a minimum, search results provide the title, designation, developer, and information on how to order the standard including, in most cases, a direct URL link to the standards developer's WWW home- or ordering-page, or to the website of a designated re-seller.



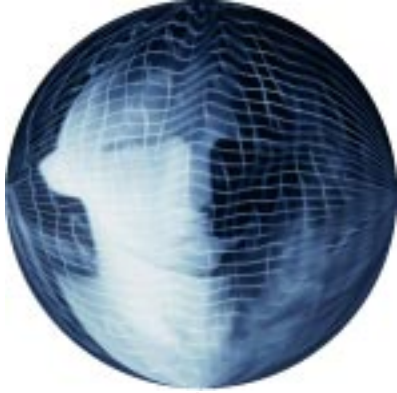
• NSSN's Standards Tracking and Automated Reporting (STAR) Service is a data management system that automatically compares user-established profiles with new project proposals, changes in the status of development projects and standards under maintenance. Registered users receive e-mail summaries and access to a personal web page containing complete details of any modification relating to their established user-profile.

Other NSSN features include:

- *QuickLinks* - direct linkage to more than 200 U.S. Government websites on standards, regulations, legislation and standardization issues.
- U.S. Standards Developers Directory - an electronic version of NIST Special Publication 806, *Standards Activities of Organizations in the United States*.
- U.S. Participation in International Activities - a searchable database on U.S. participation in the ISO and a printable file of U.S. participants in the international standards activities of the IEC.
