ANSI – the U.S. member body to the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) via its U.S. National Committee (USNC) – announced the availability of a new IEC product known as Commented Redline Version (CMV). With CMVs, stakeholders can view comments on the major changes between the previous and new edition of a standard, including the committee's explanation and rationale for changes. The first to be available is for Household and Similar Electrical Appliances – Safety – Part 1: General Requirements, IEC 60335-1:2020 CMV, through the ANSI Webstore and ANSI's subscription platform, Standards Connect.

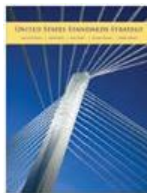
