The ANSI Procedures for the Development and Coordination of American National Standards (ANSI Procedures) provide two options for the maintenance of American National Standards (ANS): periodic maintenance (see clause 4.4.1) and continuous maintenance (see clause 4.4.2). Continuous maintenance is defined as follows:

The standard shall be maintained by an accredited standards developer. A documented program for periodic publication of revisions shall be established by the standards developer.

Processing of these revisions shall be in accordance with these procedures. The published standard shall include a clear statement of the intent to consider requests for change and information on the submittal of such requests. Procedures shall be established for timely, documented consensus action on each request for change and no portion of the standard shall be excluded from the revision process. In the event that no revisions are issued for a period of four years, action to reaffirm or withdraw the standard shall be taken in accordance with 4.4.1 and 4.4.3.

The Executive Standards Council (ExSC) has determined that for standards maintained under the Continuous Maintenance option, separate PINS announcements are not required. The following ANSI Accredited Standards Developers have formally registered standards under the Continuous Maintenance option.

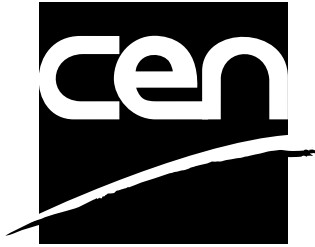

PROPOSED CHANGES FOR UL 13, STANDARD FOR SAFETY FOR POWER-LIMITED
CIRCUIT CABLES, THIRD EDITION

For your convenience in review, proposed additions to existing requirements are shown underlined and proposed deletions are shown lined-out.

1.3 A cable that contains one or more electromagnetic shields shall ~~be~~ surface marked or have a marker tape to indicate that it is "shielded". A cable that contains one or more optical-fiber members has "-OF" supplementing the type letters and is limited (see 8.3) to carrying optical energy that has been ruled not hazardous to the human body. ~~marked in accordance with 41.1 (e).~~ A cable shall ~~may~~ consist of or contain one or more coaxial members.

15.1 A jacket is required over a metal covering that is on any cable intended for direct burial. A jacket is not required over a metal covering on other cable [see 10.2(b)]. Any jacket that is provided over an armor shall comply with Cable Jacket, Section 13. The thicknesses shall be in accordance with Tables 13.1, 13.2, 13.3, and 15.1. The same calculated (see 5.1) core dimension that is used in determining the thicknesses of a cable jacket, Section 13, that is not over a metal covering is to be used in determining the thicknesses required for an over-metal jacket on cables other than Type PLTC cable - that is, an over-metal jacket need not be thicker than a cable jacket that is not over a metal covering.

PROPOSED REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FIRST EDITION OF THE STANDARD FOR SAFETY FOR FIRE PUMP CONTROLLERS, UL 218

For your convenience in review, proposed additions to existing requirements are shown underlined.

34.1 Limited service controllers shall comply with the requirements specified in Sections 1 –32.

Exception No. 1: One method to achieve the motor overcurrent protection specified in 19.3 (b) and 20.1 is to use an inverse time nonadjustable circuit breaker evaluated in accordance with the Standard for Molded-Case Circuit Breakers and Circuit Breaker Enclosures, UL 489, having a standard rating between 150 percent and 250 percent of the motor full-load current.

Exception No. 2: The manually operated isolating switch specified in Section 18, Isolating Switches, is not required.

Exception No. 3: The means to read all line currents and all line voltages on the exterior of the controller, as specified in 13.1, is not required.

Exception No. 4: The pressure recording device specified in 24.2.1.1 is not required.

36.2 A residential fire pump controller shall consist of an automatic and non-automatic across-the-line controller intending for starting, stopping and protecting squirrel-cage motors rated 240 V ac or less. Residential fire pump controllers are intended to be used in one or two family dwelling units. These controllers shall be rated for connection to a single phase alternating current source of supply.

Exception No. 1: One method to achieve the motor overcurrent protection specified in 19.3 (b) and 20.1 is to use an inverse time nonadjustable circuit breaker evaluated in accordance with the Standard for Molded-Case Circuit Breakers and Circuit Breaker Enclosures, UL 489, having a standard rating between 150 percent and 250 percent of the motor full-load current.

Exception No. 3: The means to read all line currents and all line voltages on the exterior of the controller, as specified in 13.1, is not required.

Exception No. 4: The pressure recording device specified in 24.2.1.1 is not required.

BSR/UL 923-200x

The following BSR/UL 923-200x items are being considered for public comment:

- 1) These requirements cover household and commercial microwave cooking appliances operated in the Industrial, Scientific and Medical (ISM) bands of 915 \pm 25 and 2450 \pm 50 MHz, for use in ordinary locations.
- 2) Removal of cord types HS and HSO from Table 13.1.
- 3) Deletion of soldering all strands of a wire together as a means of preventing loose strands at internal wiring connections.
- 4) Revision of paragraph 21.2 to harmonize the requirement with other UL standards that require compliance with the Standard for Overheating Protection of Motors, UL 2111.
- 5) Revision to 36.6.4.1.6 that a thermal device shall not operate during the Temperature Test.
- 6) Addition of a Waveguide Contamination Test.
- 7) Revision of the important instructions to caution users concerning heating liquids beyond the boiling point.
- 8) Proposal to add a supplement to investigate microwave ovens utilizing halogen lamps for cooking.

BSR/UL 1017-200x

The following ANSI/UL 1017-2002 items are being considered for public comment:

- 1) Addition of requirements for parts handling fluids.
- 2) Revised requirements for the Temperature Test for central vacuum cleaners to address recirculation of exhaust air.
- 3) Deletion of Clause 1.7 addressing investigation of new and different features of products.
- 4) Revisions to change "natural gray" to "gray" for identification of grounded conductors.
- 5) Revisions to update the leakage current requirements relative to measurement units.
- 6) Clarification of requirements for investigation of an appliance with recommended attachments not provided with the appliance.
- 7) Clarification of electrical rating marking for Watts.
- 8) Clarification of the test time for the production line dielectric voltage-withstand test.
- 9) Revisions to clarify the warning marking requirements in Table 17, items 1, 2, and 7.

This Advisory prescribes the requirements for course providers for identification of courses accredited under the ANSI-RAB National Accreditation Program (NAP), and for issuance of student certificates for such courses.

ADVISORY:

1. All training courses that are identified or publicized in any fashion (written, oral, electronic) as ANSI-RAB NAP accredited, must be specifically presented as so accredited.
2. All student ~~certificates of attendance or~~ certificates of successful completion for courses presented as ANSI-RAB NAP accredited shall carry the said accreditation mark.
3. Only certificates of successful completion from courses that have been specifically approved to IATCA criteria may carry the IATCA mark.
- ~~3.4.~~ Each course presentation of a so described ANSI-RAB NAP accredited course incurs an applicable fee, as shown on the current NAP Fee Schedule.
