

2020 National Activity Assessment

for ANSI-Accredited Standards Developers

The National Activity Assessment (NAA) structure is based upon the number of American National Standards (ANS), including individually approved addenda, sponsored by each developer on a graduated scale.

This administrative fee structure defrays some of the costs associated with the infrastructure that underpins the American National Standards (ANS) process. It also facilitates the budget planning processes of ANSI-Accredited Standards Developers by including the cost of the periodic mandatory audit. New ANSI-accredited standards developers (ASD) will be billed for their first audit after the approval of their first ANS, on a pro-rated basis. The fee ranges are adjusted annually.

Extraordinary services, such as the conduct of a special audit for cause if required by the ANSI Executive Standards Council (ExSC), will be billed separately. All ASDs will continue to be billed, as a separate item, for annual ANSI membership dues or the equivalent.
