³ If an ANS is under Continuous Maintenance and if no revisions are issued for a period of four years, action to revise, reaffirm, or withdraw the standard shall be initiated by the sponsoring ASD. In such a case, if the intended action is a revision, then a PINS to announce a revision is required.

⁴ Note - When the stakeholders change: If a PINS has been published and the stakeholders change, then a revised PINS must be submitted and published
