Security and Privacy Subcommittee

- Security and Privacy Matrices to be incorporated into next version of TN900
- Next:
 - Determine if the new security, privacy and consent requirements of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act warrant revisions to the Security and Privacy matrices
 - Coordinate any new effort with the Security, Privacy and Infrastructure Technical Committee



Harmonization Subcommittee

- Completed comment resolution of two value sets ready for Panel approval in June
 - Marital status value set
 - Body structure value set (as example of large value set)
- Published Demographics information model fragment for SDO comment
- Continuing Medication terminology harmonization project
- Evaluating five new areas of work for prospective harmonization
 - Administrative/Financial/Clinical models and vocabulary reconciliation
 - Clinical value set reconciliation
 - Data elements reconciliation (templates)
 - Information model reconciliation (extend demographics)
 - White paper on SDO adoption of harmonized artifacts lessons learned

Information Exchange Subcommittee

- □ Significant progress in gathering messaging syntax (message envelope requirements) from primary member SDOs
- Have begun bidirectional mapping of data elements from each SDO message envelope
- Created UML interaction diagrams
- Next steps
 - Drill down into individual data elements to identify support business requirements
 - Begin to identify the elements that could become the meta-data for a common message envelope
