

Foundations Committee Adjustments for ARRA

- □ Harmonization reduced call frequency
- Medication Terminology continue on task with every other week call
- Security & Privacy suspended calls
- □ Information Interchange continued every other week calls



Harmonization Subcommittee 2009 Plan

- 2009 projects are broader in scope, based on established principles. (Similar to the broader scope of the medication harmonization working group)
- □ From the list of potential topics, we reviewed SCO and HITSP priorities, and surveyed the membership for interest.
- This has lead to the formation of two new working groups:
 - Administrative/Financial/Clinical harmonization
 - Data element / Template harmonization



Harmonization Subcommittee 2009 Roadmap

- Administrative / Financial / Clinical harmonization (Bob Davis, lead)
 - Description: Identify where there are overlaps between administrative, financial and clinical models and vocabulary; prioritize based on HITSP use (e.g. those value sets in HITSP/C80); and harmonize.
 - Examples: living arrangement; service delivery location; administrative codes in CMS' Minimum Data Set v3.
- Data element / Template harmonization (Bob Dolin, lead)
 - Description: Identify where there are multiple data elements or templates (e.g. those in HITSP/C83) for a single use case; prioritize; and harmonize.
 - Examples: Problem status in HITSP/C32 (via observation / effectiveTime) vs. in CCD (via status code).



Medication Terminology Work Group

- Objectives
 - Document a process for converging onto a single coded concept set
 - General validation via Medication Terminology / eRx
 - Specific validation via Route of Administration
- Expanded Participation
 - Backed by the SCO Summit
- Work Plan
 - Overlapping Threads

Information Interchange - Accomplishments

- Produced Background Research Analysis Report summarizing information interchanges of HITSP SDOs
- Documented Interaction Patterns summarizing SDOs and ONC Common Data Transport requirements
- Documented Common Envelope Data Requirements (including mapping to SDO envelopes) (sender, receiver, type of payload, etc.)
- Added Information Interchange to the scope of the Harmonization Principles and Procedures document



Information Interchange - Next Steps

- □ Finalize Information Interchange Analysis Report
- □ Finalize Information Interchange Harmonization: Principles and Process Document
- Two Information Interchange Harmonization pilot projects
 - HL7 / NCPDP common framework for a query/response pattern
 - HL7 / NCPDP / X12N services based information interchange for provider registry



Panel Approval Requested

- □ Foundations seeks Panel approval for revisions to HITSP 07 N 272 HITSP Foundations Committee Harmonization Process approved 12/13/2007.
- Document updated to include procedures for harmonizing information models and information interchange approaches

 - Marital status value set
 - Demographics information model
