RE: Panel Approved HITSP Interoperability Specification - CORRECTION

The Healthcare Information Technology Standards Panel (HITSP) approved the following set of documents at the July 8, 2009, Panel meeting:

- EHR-Centric Interoperability Specification (IS107) and referenced constructs

As reported at the Panel meeting, there were three additional edits to the documents that were explained to and approved by the Panel (reference document HITSP 09 N 412 Rev. 1, slide 16) When the editorial staff were making these corrections this week, an additional necessary edit was uncovered. The content of the edit was included previously in HITSP-IS01, but was inadvertently left out of HITSP-IS107. This edit is as follows:

Changes made to IS107:

Capability 126:

- Added subset descriptions for HITSP/C36 and HITSP/C35

Capability 127:

- Changed Optionality on Document Display subset, Document Import subset and Lab Report Discrete Data General Lab subset to be R (Required) rather than C (Conditional)
- For Lab Report Discrete Data Microbiology Import subset, removed a condition and renumbered remaining condition. A description for the condition was also added
- Added subset descriptions for HITSP/C37 and HITSP/C35

As this edit was not specifically stated to the Panel at last week's meeting, this correction is now being brought to attention of the Panel through this message. The Panel will now have 5 business days to review this edit. **If no objections are made by close of business, Wednesday, July 22, 2009**, this document edit will be incorporated into the Panel approved version of HITSP-IS107.
