Expectations

- NHIEs must implement HITSP Interoperability Specifications
 - May deviate from them, but requires justification to do so
 - Mandated use for federal partners via executive order
- HITSP to work closely with the NHIN participants in support of implementation of the HITSP Interoperability Specifications
 - Provide liaison for first level of technical support and inter-project coordination
 - Provide educational support on use of ISs
 - Defined process for handling roadmap requests
 - Provide review and comments on the Implementation Specifications developed by the NHIN WGs



Opportunities

- Collaborate on addressing gaps
 - NHIEs will, by necessity, build out areas where HITSP has identified gaps
 - Will seek guidance from HITSP on how to move forward on gaps
- Improve the Interoperability Specifications (ISs)
 - Capture issues related to the use of ISs by the NHIN implementers
 - Readability
 - Completeness
 - Accessability



Recent Activity

- Current workgroups completing their draft specifications
 - DURSA, Testing, Core Services Content, Technical and Security
 - March 31 Due to ONC
 - Schedule for HITSP comment period and process
- New use case workgroups now in action
 - Provider
 - Population
 - Consumer
- ONC is identifying priority flows from the AHIC use cases for the workgroups to focus on



Pending Activity

- Roadmap Requests
 - IRB to review and forward first request from NHIN on use of web services for core services
- Training
 - UC WGs will be focused on the implementation of specific flows from each UC
 - ONC has requested a series of sessions be held, one for each IS
 - Target date is to begin week of April 7

2008 HIMSS Annual Conference & Exhibition


- ☐ February 24-28th in Orlando, FL
