Workshop on Water and Sanitation Systems in India: Leveraging standards for infrastructure improvement

Millions of people in India lack access to safe water and improved sanitation. The Government of India aims to achieve 100% universal sanitation by 2019 to provide safe, piped water for at least 90% of its population by 2022. To reach these goals, India must continue to invest in cutting-edge solutions and services to provide increase access to reliable, sustainable and affordable water and sanitation services.

During this 2-day workshop, presentations by U.S. and Indian experts from both the private and public sectors will focus on standards-related aspects of water supply to point of use, water quality, and wastewater.
