



Workshop on Smart & Sustainable Cities: Leveraging Technology for Smart, Safe and Sustainable Buildings and Cities

U.S.–India Standards and Conformance Cooperation Program, Phase II

India aims to reach 40% urbanization by 2030. Launched in 2015 by the Government of India, the Smart City Mission is supporting India's efforts by creating walkable localities, preserving and developing open spaces, and promoting a variety of transportation options. To reach 40% urbanization, India will need to improve city planning, implement redevelopment, and modernize infrastructure to facilitate smart and sustainable cities across the country.

The program will provide an overview of smart cities in India, as well as address smart technologies and programs that support the built environment, including improving resilience, energy efficiency, and interoperability. U.S. and Indian experts from the private and public sectors will present on the effective implementation of high-quality standards, including through a robust conformity assessment framework for smart and sustainable cities. Participants will learn about the importance of strong building codes and their effective enforcement in laying the foundation for smart cities that meet the goals of sustainability, resilience and the effective provision of citizen services.
