Overall don't have any issues with the modifications, but did notice the footnote numbering needs to be fixed throughout (i.e. footnote #1 was deleted, but numbering not revised for remaining footnotes). Probably caught by now....

Some comments from others on my team – unedited (reference only, does not need to be fed back):

- (lines 47-49) Trade associations and professional societies were removed for additional interest categories. These entities will now fall under one of the other interests as indicated in the revised text in 2.3.
- (lines 73-84) In clauses 1.5 & 2.5, vague verbiage added to elaborate on timing of notifications and development. It does not prescribe real values for timing (e.g. 30 days), but should give members the ability to push back when timing is deemed “not reasonable”.
- (Lines 89-105) 2.5.1 adds interest categories as part of project initiation notification and timeline for interested parties and SDO reply (party comment within 30 day of notice publication and SDO reply within 30 days from comment deadline).
- (lines 132-157) 2.8.2 adds clarity on the appeals process, includes both SDO and Executive Standards Council levels as well as cases of Audited Designator.
