Subject: Comment on revision of Commercial Terms

In the proposed revision of ANSI's Commercial Terms and Conditions, the second paragraph of section 3.2.2 (below) is somewhat unclear as written. In the following, I have redacted the lines crossed out in the proposed language.

AS PROPOSED

"However, for informational purposes, where known sources exist for products or services necessary to comply with the ANS, **it is permissible but not obligatory** to identify the name and address of the sources in a footnote...etc."

Is the intent to say that the sources MAY be included (with name and address) if so desired, but the sources do not HAVE to be included? The "not obligatory" refers to the option for inclusion, not the option for supplying the name and address if included.

If that is the case, then a suggested re-write is:

SUGGESTED REWORDING

"However, for informational purposes, where known sources exist for products or services necessary to comply with the ANS, there is no obligation to identify those sources, but it is permissible to identify them with name and address in a footnote...etc."
