Good afternoon –

Thank you for submitting public comments in response to the ANSI Executive Standards Council's (ExSC) third public announcement of a proposed revision to section 3.2 *Commercial terms and conditions* of the *ANSI Essential Requirements: Due process requirements for American National Standards* (www.ansi.org/essentialrequirements). The ExSC considered all public comments received and made several edits, approving the attached final version which will now be submitted to the Executive Committee of the ANSI Board of Directors for final approval.

With respect to your specific comments (attached), the ExSC refers you to their prior response (also attached) and notes the following:

- The ExSC does not agree that it is necessary to name other sections in 3.2. The *Essential Requirements* in its entirety governs the American National Standards (ANS) process and is subject to change over time.
- When revisions to the *Essential Requirements* are issued annually, all ASDs have one-year to update their procedures and any proposed ANS will be assessed based on the current text of the *ANSI Essential Requirements*.
- The *ANSI Essential Requirements* governs the ANS development and approval process and that is the only context in which it applies. Further clarification of this point within section 3.2 is not warranted.
