The Restriction of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive has been implemented for over a year. There are questions about its enforcement and about the revision of the directive which is underway. The Energy Using Products (EuP) "framework" Directive was recently implemented. This directive enables the European Commission, upon the recommendation by a working group, to name implementing measures setting environment requirements for specific products.
