 - Project Management Professional (PMP)® 932,720
 - Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM)® 39,120
- 533,924 members

Timeline



CAPM

- Starting 28 August for CAPM certification holders, we are waiving the 35 hours of education required to apply for the Project Management Professional (PMP)[®] certification.
- A secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree or the global equivalent) 1,500 hours of project experience **OR** 23 hours of project management education completed by the time of the exam
- \$300 non-member, \$225 member, \$257 student bundle
- PearsonVue testing center or Online Proctored

Is a certification valuable?

- In the United States, among survey respondents, those with a PMP certification garner a higher salary (22% higher on average) than those without a PMP certification.
- 73% of respondents said that a Project Management Career Path was Connected to Roles in Upper Management through either “Clearly defined/in writing” or informal policies.
- CAPM® globally recognized credential providing a PM framework


