WHO ISSUES THE CERTIFICATION?

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE CERTIFICATION?

The [CEET](#) demonstrates a vendor-neutral, cross-industry, and multidisciplinary understanding of applied technology ethics that will enable holders to navigate the processes by which ethical integrity may be upheld within emerging data-driven technology fields (such as artificial intelligence (AI)/ machine learning, Internet of Things (IoT), and data science).

WHAT IS THE CAREER LEVEL OF THE CERTIFICATION AND WHO IS IT GEARED TO?

The CEET is an advanced/specialization certification geared to professionals working in data-driven technology fields who want to focus on the ethical use of data across multiple sectors and uses.

WHAT ARE THE EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE PREREQUISITES FOR THE CERTIFICATION?

The CEET has no formal prerequisites.

WHAT IS THE COST AND STRUCTURE OF THE CERTIFICATION'S EXAM(S)?

The CEET exam is made up of 80 multiple-choice questions and takes 120 minutes to complete. It costs \$350.

WHAT IS THE GEOGRAPHIC SCOPE OF THE CERTIFICATION?

International.

IS THE CERTIFICATION ACCREDITED?

No.

HOW LONG IS THE CERTIFICATION VALID?

It is valid for three years.

IS THERE A PROCESS FOR RENEWING THE CERTIFICATION, OR RECERTIFICATION?

Yes, to renew the CEET the holder must retake the exam.

CAN THE CERTIFICATION BE REVOKED?

Yes, the CEET can be revoked for criminal activity, fraud, or deceit in the certification process, and failing to comply with the candidate agreement.

HOW DOES THE CERTIFICATION RELATE TO OTHER CERTNEXUS CERTIFICATIONS OR THOSE OF OTHER CERTIFICATION BODIES?

While there is no defined relationship between the CEET and other certifications, it could be complementary to the Certified Artificial Intelligence Practitioner™ (CAIP), Certified Data Science Practitioner (CDSP), or Certified Internet of Things Practitioner (CIoTP) from CertNexus. Additionally, CertNexus is developing an associated micro-credential called DEBIZ: Data Ethics for Business Professionals that aligns with CEET, which is expected to be available in the fall of 2021.

WHAT ARE SOME ORGANIZATIONS OR INDUSTRIES THAT RECOGNIZE OR USE THE CERTIFICATION?

Industries include data science, AI, and engineering. In addition, the Montreal AI Ethics Institute and the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers recognize the certification as aligning to their standards.

ARE THERE ANY COMPANIES, CORPORATIONS, OR OTHER ORGANIZATIONS THAT HAVE PUBLICLY DECLARED THEY PREFER OR REQUIRE THE CERTIFICATION?

Because the CEET is a new certification, it is too early to identify organizations that publically declare they prefer or require it.

WHAT OCCUPATIONS USE THE CERTIFICATION?

Data analyst, UX designer, product manager, and AI engineer are examples of occupations that use the CEET.

DOES CERTNEXUS OFFER TRAINING MATERIALS TO HELP INDIVIDUALS PREPARE FOR THE CERTIFICATION EXAM?

Yes, they offer a series of online courses through Coursera and other authorized training centers (globally) for the CEET. For other certifications, CertNexus also offers self-paced training materials, self-study guides, and materials for instructor-led courses.
